- 6) All fully grown vegetables must be brought to 5 Oaks Garden Center on Highway 129 in Batesville, IN by 4pm on Friday of each week.
- 7) One winner in each category of melons, beets, tomatoes, squash, cucumbers, and potatoes will be announced at the end of the contest held Wednesday, October 19, 2022 between 11am-Noon. WRBI will be broadcasting live from 5 Oaks Garden Center.
