VOTE BY TRAVELING BOARD.

This method is for a confined voter, a voter caring for a confined person or a voter with disabilities.

This allows the voter to vote an absentee ballot from their place of confinement within Decatur County.

The first day TRAVEL BOARD VOTING will begin on OCTOBER 20, 2022 and will continue until the deadline date.
