- 3) Try to grow outstanding melons, beets, tomatoes, squash, cucumbers, and potatoes. Any variety may be used in growing your vegetables. 5 Oaks Garden Center recommends the use of Ferti•Lome Blooming & Rooting Fertilizer to increase your chances of winning one of the categories.
- 4) One entry per person, per week.
- 5) Anyone over two years of age is eligible to participate.
- 6) All fully grown vegetables must be brought to 5 Oaks Garden Center on Highway 129 in Batesville, IN by 4pm on Friday of each week.
- 7) One winner in each category of cabbage, melons, squash, tomatoes, and beets will be announced at the end of the contest held Wednesday, October 18, 2023 between 11am-Noon. WRBI will be broadcasting live from 5 Oaks Garden Center.
- 8) Winners will have their picture taken and will win various prizes from 5 Oaks Garden Center and WRBI. Photos will be posted to WRBIradio.com.
